Hamilton Health Center is the only Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) serving a growing number of residents in Dauphin County and beyond – with services extending into Perry County. Hamilton currently serves the community from four active locations, including its headquarters in the City of Harrisburg and three satellite locations. Our satellite location at Downey Elementary School in Harrisburg is set to reopen next year, along with a new Steelton care location that is currently under construction.

A CHANGING DEMOGRAPHIC LANDSCAPE

Demographics at Hamilton have remained steady over the last three years with one notable exception – older patients.

While the vast majority of our patient population is in the 18-64 age range, for the fifth straight year, the percentage of older adults (age 65 and over) utilizing Hamilton services has increased dramatically.

There are many factors leading to the increase in older people seeking out Hamilton services, including an overall aging population and the rise in life expectancy. Hamilton is a known and trusted community resource which offers a variety of services that cater to the unique needs of older adults, including transportation to medical appointments, meal delivery, and social activities.

We will continue to adapt and evolve our services to meet the changing needs of our senior population.




PATIENT OVERVIEW






